August 15, 2011 – MISSISSAUGA, Ontario – Enersource has taken a major step toward achieving energy reduction targets mandated by the Ontario government.

Willis Energy Services has been competitively selected to support Enersource in its delivery of Conservation and Demand Management (CDM) program initiatives for Commercial and Institutional (C&I) customers located in Mississauga.

“There are many programs for businesses to take control of their energy usage,” said Craig Fleming, President and Chief Executive Officer at Enersource. “We are pleased to be working with Willis Energy Services to help our customers find energy efficiencies.”

Business customers may be eligible for the **Energy Audit Initiative** which offers incentives to participants for conducting electricity demand and consumption assessments.

Likewise, the **Equipment Replacement Incentive Initiative (ERII)**, which was previously known as the Equipment Replacement Incentive Program (ERIP), provides capital incentives to replace existing electrically powered systems with more efficient equipment. Those who qualify can receive funding for up to 50% of the project costs (as applicable under program rules) to upgrade equipment such as:

- Lighting fixtures and controls
- Heating, ventilation, and air conditioning systems
- Building controls and automation

The **High Performance New Construction (HPNC)** program is another major initiative designed to promote “*building it better new*” through incentives for business customers to install the most efficient equipment during construction.

The **Building Commissioning Initiative** is an incentive program for chilled water systems that are over three years old. Eligible customers must have systems with facility cooling areas of more than 50,000 square feet. General service customers with load greater than 50 kW are eligible.

“We are excited to be working with Enersource,” said Parminder Sandhu, Managing Director at Willis Energy Services. “We look forward to helping them achieve their CDM targets and making Mississauga businesses more energy efficient.”
