

Winter is over! Now it's time to adjust your thermostat from Heat to Cool

1. Open the door and press the **“SYSTEM”** button until the word **“COOL”** is in the upper right corner of the display.



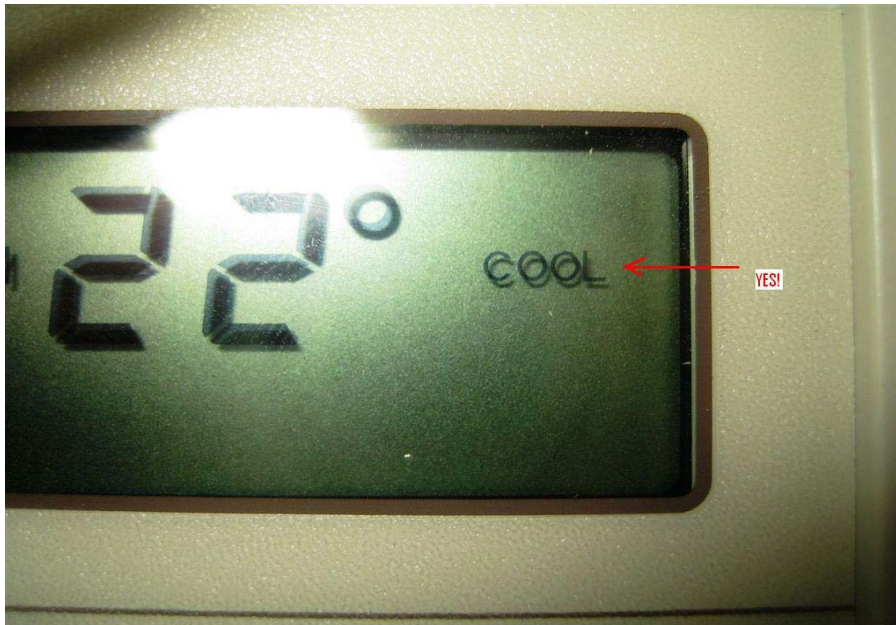
2. If it is showing **“HEAT”** go to step 3, if it showing **“COOL”** skip to step 4



3. Press the “SYSTEM” button. It is at centre of the bottom row of buttons.



4. The display will change to “COOL”. Set the temperature to your desired temperature (example 22°C or 72°F). You will hear a faint “click” and the A/C will come on. On some systems the A/C has a built-in delay and the unit will not come on for 10 or 15 minutes.



- If the A/C still does not come on verify step 4 to ensure the word “COOL” is on the display and the temperature is set to a typical temperature. (example 22°C).

Additional troubleshooting tips

- Remember that you need to check that the A/C cover has been removed.
- Make sure that A/C power breaker is switched on. Your breaker color could be any color; but most likely black. It should have the number 20, 25 or even 30 on it. Turn it on and give the A/C a few minutes to turn on after you have changed the settings in your thermostat.
